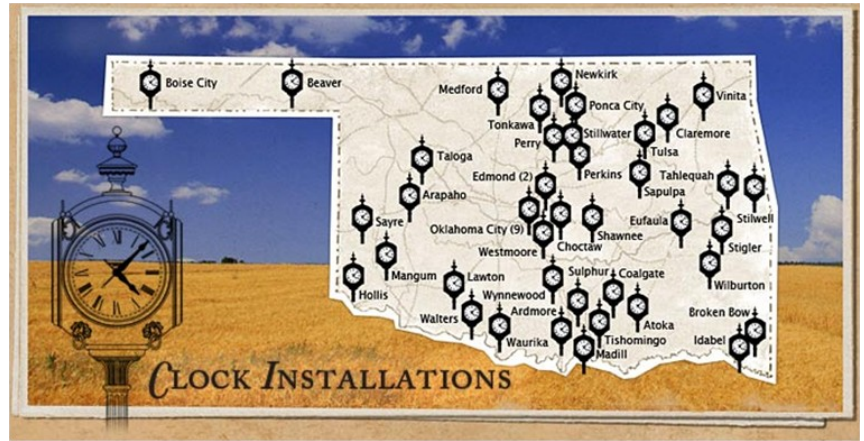

This state project aligns with the LBA class choice of providing a clock tower for downtown Broken Arrow while expands upon the community's focus to revitalize the downtown area.
