

Indoor RV facility planned for Broken Arrow

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CoachPort LLC has announced plans to build a \$5 million, 252-unit, all-steel, indoor, secure, RV storage facility on 17.5 acres east of Broken Arrow on Highway 51, one mile east of the Creek Turnpike.

The first two buildings of the 24-building complex should be finished about mid-May.

All construction is scheduled for completion in two phases over an 18- to 24-month period.

The Tulsa facility could be the beginning of a five-state regional chain for Oklahoma, Texas, Arkansas, Kansas and Missouri.

CoachPort is responding to a growing demand in the Tulsa area for indoor and secure storage of RV vehicles, including boats and classic cars.

A market survey indicated that most RV storage facilities in the Tulsa area have a waiting list.

The CoachPort complex will be part of an upcoming Broken Arrow tax increment financing district.

CoachPort features include paving, landscaping, automated gate with keypad entry, outdoor security lighting, interior lighting, and on-site water and dump stations.

Most of the 24 buildings will have 11 spaces with doors that are 12 feet wide and 14 feet high.

Rates will be \$165 per month for a six-month lease or \$150 per month for a 12-month lease, all paid in advance.

Responding to customer interest and demand in recent weeks, CoachPort will now have 50-amp hookup options in every unit. Spaces using 50-amp service would be priced at \$250 per month.
