Dear Applicant:

The 2012 Miss Broken Arrow Outstanding Teen Pageant will be held on Saturday, Oct. 29, 2011 at the Broken Arrow Northeastern State University auditorium (NSU). Miss Broken Arrow Teen is affiliated with the largest scholarship provider in the world, the Miss America Pageant. This is a one-day pageant with cash and trophies awarded to the winners. In order to participate in the teen pageant you must be 13 to 17 years of age by July 31st, when you attend the 2012 National Pageant in August. The contestant must be a resident of Broken Arrow, attending a public, private or home-schooled program on a full-time basis. (See enclosed requirements).

Enclosed you will find information that you will need to fill out on all required forms. An entry form with \$110.00 in the form of a cashier’s check is required when returning the completed application. The check should be made out to “Miss Broken Arrow Pageant”, who is the sponsor of the Teen Pageant.

Each application should be returned to the Broken Arrow Area Chamber of Commerce office located at 210 South Main, Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, no later than Monday, October 3, 2011. Each application will be time and date stamped. Examples have been given to you for help with resume and platform. If you need assistance in filling out the forms, please call the entries chairperson, Donna Baldwin.

**BROKEN ARROW'S OUTSTANDING TEEN
CONTESTANT ELIGIBILITY
RULES & REGULATIONS**

- A. A contestant may not compete unless she has made application to participate and meets the following requirements as set by the Miss Broken Arrow organization.
- B. A contestant shall not be less than 13 years of age on the date of the local pageant in which she competes, nor more than 17 years of age on July 31 of the year of the Miss America Outstanding Teen Pageant in which she will compete.
- C. Contestant must be enrolled in and attending classes on a full-time basis at an accredited public, private, or home-schooled program with at least a 2.75 GPA and maintaining an 80% attendance.
- D. A contestant may compete if she is a bona fide resident of Broken Arrow living within the Zip Code areas as defined by the Broken Arrow Post Office and has been a bona fide resident for a period of six months immediately preceding the date of the Broken Arrow's Outstanding Teen Pageant competition. A contestant must supply proof of residency consisting of a copy of two of the following:
1. Current drivers license issued in the State of competition or current registration issued in the state of competition; or
 2. Current lease in the contestant's or parent's/guardian's name of housing in the Broken Arrow zip code area; or
 3. Current utility bills in the contestant's or parent's/guardian's name in the Broken Arrow zip code area; or
- E. She must be a citizen of the United States at the time of competing.

One or more of the requirements set forth in paragraphs B, C, D and E above, must be at the time of the Broken Arrow's Outstanding Teen Pageant and the Miss Oklahoma's Outstanding Teen Pageant and the Miss Oklahoma's Outstanding Teen Pageant and, if selected, must remain in effect through conclusion of the Miss Oklahoma Finals, as applicable.

The Pageant Board has the right to reject information if it feels that the above documentation has not been gathered or provided in good faith.

These rules are in accordance with the Miss Broken Arrow Pageant with adaptations made and approved by the Miss Broken Arrow Scholarship Pageant Board of Trustees.

Miss Broken Arrow Outstanding Teen Instructions for Preparing the Judges Resume

Remember this is your opportunity to demonstrate to the judges why they should consider you for the position of Miss Local's Outstanding Teen. You may list as many or as few items under each category as you desire. This one page, combined with your Platform Statement, and your Local Pageant Contestant Contract will comprise your entire application for the responsibility of becoming Miss Local's Outstanding Teen. The judges will receive your resume exactly as it is submitted. **Do not put your age on the Resume!**

1. Set margins for 1" on all four sides. The font style may not be any smaller than "10" and no larger than "12" point type, using the Times Roman font style.
2. With the justification set for left, type "**Name:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the tab key two or three times. Then, type your name as you wish the judges to know it. (If your name is Mary Deborah Smith and you want to be known as "Deborah Smith", please type "Deborah Smith").
3. Then, move to the next line and type "**Title:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the tab key two or three times. Then, type the "Local" title for which you are competing.
4. Then, move to the next line and type "**Hometown:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the tab key two or three times. Then type your hometown including the city and the state.
5. Double space down. Type "**Education:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the tab key two or three times. Then type your most recent school first. List in order with the most recent, all schools attended (high school, middle school, elementary school, Pre-K, etc.).
6. Double space down. Type "**Platform Issue:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the tab key two or three times. Type the title of your platform, making sure it lines up with the other information above it. Do not type anything other than the platform title.
7. Double space down. Type "**Scholastic/Career Ambition:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the tab key one or so times. Then type the type of degree/education you would ultimately like to achieve, making sure it lines up with the other information above it. Beneath that, list your career ambition.
8. Double space down. Type "**Talent:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the tab key two or three times. Type the type of talent you will perform and specific selection, making sure it lines up with the information above it. (e.g., Pop Vocal - "Gold", Tap Dance - "Staying Alive", etc.)
9. Double space down. Type "**Scholastic Honors:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the space bar twice. Type your scholastic honors. Each item should be separated by a semi-colon (;).
10. Double space down. Type "**Leadership Roles:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the space bar twice. Each item should be separated by a semi-colon (;).
11. Double space down. Type "**Accomplishments:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the space bar twice. Each item should be separated by a semi-colon (;). **Do not include any previous local titles held in the Miss America's Outstanding Teen Program!**



12. Double space down. Type “**Interesting Facts:**” in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the space bar twice. Each item should be separated by a semi-colon (;). **Do not include any previous local titles held in the Miss America’s Outstanding Teen Program!**
13. Double space down. Type “**Marketing Plan:**” in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the space bar twice. In sentence form, explain how you would market the Miss Local’s or Miss State’s Outstanding Teen “brand”. Please include any relevant experience you have which may uniquely qualify you to serve in this position. Please be aware that a portion of the Miss Local’s or Miss State’s Outstanding Teen responsibilities includes marketing the Miss Local’s or Miss State’s Outstanding Teen program to potential sponsors, educational institutions, and organizations.
14. Double space down. Type “**Legacy:**” in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the space bar twice. This should be typed in sentence form. Please write what your legacy, as Miss Local’s Outstanding Teen will be. This statement should answer the question, “A year after giving up your title as Miss Local’s Outstanding Teen, what will people remember about your year of service?”
15. Double space down. Type “**Why I should be Miss Local’s Outstanding Teen 20__:**” in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the space bar twice. This should be typed in sentence form. Explain to the judging panel why you should be selected Miss Local’s Outstanding Teen and, more importantly, why you should be selected Miss Local’s Outstanding Teen this year.

Important Information Regarding the Contestant Resume

Please remember that the entire form MUST FIT ON ONE PAGE using the Times Roman font style.

You must leave a 1” margin on all four side of the page. Use your best judgment on what is most important for the judges to know about you. Use your space wisely. Please review the example of what the resume format look like. Any variations from this format will be returned to you and will not be accepted. Your materials will not be retyped. The judges will receive your original work.

CHECK SPELLING AND GRAMMAR!!

This resume, your platform statement, and the Miss America’s Outstanding Teen Program book will be the only documents the judges will receive about you. By submitting these forms to your local teen organization, you certify that everything on your forms is true and accurate. If it is proven that any information on these forms are not true, correct, and factual, you risk losing your title.

Some spacing issues may arise. Simply follow the example provided. Depending upon the set up of your document, you may need to press the “tab key” fewer or more times than indicated above).

Do not attempt to change margins, font, size options, or deviate from the requested criteria as set forth in this document.

Use plain white paper for the document. Do not use paper with logos, crowns, names, decorations, or other embellishments. It will not be accepted if it is printed on anything other than plain white 8 ½” X 11” paper.

Instructions for Preparing the Platform Statement

Please remember, this **ONE (1) page, single-spaced** document combined with the Contestant's Resume, will comprise your entire application for the responsibility of becoming Miss Local's Outstanding Teen. The judges will receive exactly what is submitted. Any items submitted that do not fit the established criteria will be returned for correction only once. Any items that do not meet the criteria or are submitted after the deadline will not be given to the judges. If your Platform Statement arrives on the day of the deadline, but does not meet the criteria, there will not be time to return it to you; **therefore, it will not be given to the judges**. The contestant may explain the lack of judging materials during her interview, if she so chooses.

Contestants: Discuss your *personal* platform. In addition, explain how you will further the Miss Local's Outstanding Teen Program, the Miss State's Outstanding Teen Program, and the Miss America's Outstanding Teen Program "brand" to the public.

(See sample essay.)

1. Set margins for 1" on all four sides. The font style may not be any smaller than "10" and no larger than "12" point type using the Times New Roman font style.
2. With the justification set for left, type "**Name:**" in **bold**. Following the colon (:), press the space bar twice. Then, type your name as you wish the judges to know it. (If your name is Mary Deborah Smith and you want to be known as "Deborah Smith", please type "Deborah Smith").
3. Double space down. Set your justification to "center". Then type in **Bold and underline** the title of your Platform.
4. Double space down. Write what you feel is critical for the judge's to know about your platform and why it is necessary for you to have the position of Miss Local to promote this platform. What you write will be what the judges know about your platform, your role in successfully dealing with this platform, and the role the Miss Local's Outstanding Teen Organization, the Miss State's Outstanding Teen Organization, or the Miss America's Outstanding Teen Organization may play in your plan.
5. Remember to include in the Platform Statement what **you** can do to get the message out and get more of your friends and other teens interested in the Miss Local's Outstanding Teen Program, the Miss State's Outstanding Teen Program, and the Miss America's Outstanding Teen Program.
6. **Remember to single space the text that you are typing.**
7. This essay may include some of the following items (this is not to be meant as an exhaustive list):
 - A clear definition of your platform and the specific issues you wish to address
 - A plan on how you have or will create awareness of the platform
 - The way in which you have or will change attitudes regarding the issue
 - The way in which you have or will change behaviors related to this issue
 - The way in which your platform issue will move the Miss Local's Outstanding Teen Program, the Miss State's Outstanding Teen Program, and the Miss America's Outstanding Teen Program forward
 - Your media plans
 - Your marketing strategy
 - How you propose to fund your ideas/plans
 - Any significant accomplishments you already have made in regard to your issue

Teen Volunteerism: Finding Yourself in Others

“If you look deep within, you will find a brilliant light. Far too many squint and turn away from the shine. Let your eyes adjust, and bathe in the radiance.” – Unknown.

My life journey has been shaped and molded through many experiences. I have developed a burning passion for the hearts of teenagers, and to help them find their inner light to shine brightly for the dark world around them. Through volunteerism, I am able to touch the lives of so many around me, but also allow my heart to be touched in the process. My own experiences have revealed to me life’s true importance, and allow me to convey a clear message of the amazing rewards from serving others.

When I was 11 years old, my gymnastics career was at its peak. My skill was unstoppable. Then came the day where my world was rocked; I was diagnosed with scoliosis. My spine had developed an S-shaped curve that was said to be reversed with a hard brace. Wearing it 23 hours a day was uncomfortable and impossible to hide. While enduring all the stares and whispers, I found not only was the brace not reversing my curve, but my spine had gotten severely worse. I struggled to continue my competitions as I moved onto another brace. Although it was supposed to be a miracle cure, in the end the brace was just another empty promise. What I found out now was that my spine was curved 51 and 55 degrees and was twisting itself around, literally growing into my lung. My freshman year I underwent surgery, spending a grueling ten hours in the operating room. I was left with nothing, except two completely fused titanium rods and over fifty screws. My gymnastics career was completely over. My new goal became bending to tie my shoe, and that took over a year.

The experience was humbling. Being in the ICU of a children’s hospital has a way of making you feel extremely blessed, regardless of your circumstance. Someone always has it much worse. Through this observation, I realized that I was called to serve, so I started volunteering at the Little Lighthouse. What started out as one volunteer day a week quickly jumped to five. My heart was stolen by the special needs toddlers who desperately relied on me for help with basic skills. I thought that I was impacting their lives, but I quickly found that my heart had been shaped by them. Each child has a light within themselves, and they shine brighter than any others I have ever seen. Even through their darkness, they sparkle with confidence, and reach for my hand to guide them.

My hope as a teen contestant in the Miss America system is to be a positive role model for teens. Teenagers today are not exposed to things that cause them to think outside themselves. Most struggle with substance abuse, depression, and identity issues. They desperately try to find themselves, but look in all of the wrong places. I am ready to serve my community and state and work on a program to take to schools and organizations across our state. Although I am new to the pageant world, I could not feel more ready to represent Oklahoma as Miss Oklahoma’s Outstanding Teen. To me, it’s bigger than just pretty dresses and sparkly crowns. To me, the title is many doors opened to allow me to spread my passion like wildfire. As Miss Teen Oklahoma, I am ready to help today’s youth confidently illuminate their light within to find themselves in others.
